



Special Education Transportation

All Special Education Transportation serviced requests must be submitted through ESPED via the Transportation Services Eligibility Form.

Extended School Year

- Forms for submitted to the Transportation Department no later than April 16, 2017 Forms for students receiving special needs transportation for Extended School Year (ESY) should be submitted to the Transportation Department no later than April 16, 2017.

New Students

- New students should be informed that it takes 3-5 school days to process their request once the completed form has been received by the Transportation Routing Department.
- New enrollees for the 2017-2018 school year must submit a Transportation Services Eligibility Form no later than Aug 16, 2017 in order to be assigned a special needs route for the first day of school.

Existing Student

- Students receiving special needs transportation during the 2017-2018 school year with continuing eligibility for the 2017-2018 school year need to submit a Transportation Services Eligibility Form with the Following Year Services box marked. Please verify the information reflects changes to address, phone, or contact information as well as equipment or status changes – i.e. the need for a car seat, need for a safety vest, can be left unattended, etc. This form should be submitted through ESPED no later than May 27, 2017.
- All general education students who currently require special needs transportation with continuing eligibility for the 2017-2018 school year should submit an updated Section 504 Transportation Request Form to the Transportation Department no later than May 27, 2017.

All transportation forms submitted after the Aug 16, 2017 deadline will be processed in the order they are received by the Routing Department and may take up to 10 full business days to process.
